SETTING A WHITE STILL LIFE

Still Life Definition

 Inanimate objects such as fruit, flowers, food and everyday items are painted as the main focus of interest.

The term comes from the Dutch 'stilleven'

 Used from about 1650 as a collective name for this type of subject matter.

How to Arrange Objects in a Still Life

- Choose objects of a variety of shapes, forms, colors, and textures.
- Odd number of objects.
- White draped backdrop.
- Place objects so that some overlap.
- Form connections that lead the eye around the composition.

Giorgio Morandi July 20, 1890 – June 18, 1964

- Italian painter and printmaker who specialized in still life.
- Tonal subtlety in depicting apparently simple subjects, which were limited mainly to vases, bottles, bowls, flowers and landscapes.



How To Make a Still Life Composition More Interesting

•Try viewing the objects from bizarre angles rather than just eye-level (directly above or from a vantage point below eye level or even below if placed on a glass tabletop.)

 Lighting – dramatic to show shapes and shadows.
