DIRECTOR'S NOTES

"God should have made girls lethal/when he made monsters of men." —Elisabeth Hewer

The monsters walk among us. Hamill's boldly feminist version of Bram Stoker's original, which was thick with sexism disguised as protection, resulting in Mina being left to Dracula's designs, is a refreshing reframing. Though deliciously fun and funny, this *Dracula* is a direct response to the #MeToo Movement, sparked in 2017, as a result of many women coming forward to accuse the wildly successful and uber powerful Hollywood producer Harvey Weinstein of abuse of power and sexual assault—and many more women admitting in their Twitter feeds that they too, had had these experiences in their own lives. This issue is ubiquitous. But with this sea change, the hope is that we push the needle further in the direction of equality, empathy—and a world where all people are seen as having value, no matter what their gender.




