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Katy Ambrose is Assistant Professor of Horn at the University of Iowa. From 2015-21 she was on faculty at the University of Virginia, and Principal Horn of the Charlottesville Symphony. Ambrose's extensive orchestral experience includes having held positions in many regional orchestras throughout the United States and substituting with major ensembles such as the Boston Pops, Philadelphia Orchestra, Kansas City Symphony, Daejeon Philharmonic, Hawai'i Symphony, Richmond Symphony, and the Virginia Symphony. A dedicated chamber musician, she is a founding member of the Lanta Horn Duo and was a co-founder of Seraph Brass. Ambrose spends her summers in Northern Michigan teaching at the Bay View Music Festival, and previously at the Curtis Institute of Music Young Artists Summer Program, and the (now-defunct) All-State program at Interlochen Arts Camp. Dr. Ambrose received her Doctor of Musical Arts from Temple University, Artist Diploma from Yale University, master's from Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, and bachelor's from the University of Michigan. Ambrose lives in Iowa City with her husband Carsten, a software engineer and amateur violinist, their twin sons, and cat, Milo.
