ABOUT THE AUTHORS

Brittany Cavallaro is the New York Times bestselling author of the Charlotte Holmes novels, including A Study in Charlotte, and the historical fantasy duology Muse (HarperCollins/Katherine Tegen Books). With Emily Henry, she is the author of *Hello Girls* (HarperCollins/Katherine Tegen Books), which was hailed by Entertainment Weekly as a top ten young adult novel of the year. Most recently, she wrote the young adult verse novel Sunrise Nights with Jeff Zentner (HarperCollins/Quill Tree), which earned four starred reviews. Her novels have been translated into more than a dozen languages and optioned for film and television. The recipient of a fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts, Cavallaro is also an accomplished poet, with work appearing or forthcoming in Poetry, American Poetry Review, Yale Review, and elsewhere. Her poetry collections Girl-King and Unhistorical (University of Akron Press) were both honorable mentions for Literary Hub's Best Poetry Collections of the Decade. She holds a PhD in English literature and creative writing from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, an M.F.A. in poetry from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and is a graduate of Interlochen Arts Academy, where she now teaches poetry and novel writing. She lives with her husband in Traverse City.

Jeff Zentner is the author of New York Times Notable Books *The Serpent King* and *In the Wild Light*, as well as *Goodbye Days*, *Rayne & Delilah's Midnite Matinee*, his debut for the adult market, *Colton Gentry's Third Act*, and a YA novel in verse, *Sunrise Nights*, coauthored with Brittany Cavallaro. Among other honors, he has won the ALA's William C. Morris Award, the Amelia Elizabeth Walden Award twice, the Muriel Becker Award, the International Literacy Association Award, and been longlisted for the Crook's Corner Book Prize and twice for the Carnegie Medal. He's a two-time Southern Book Prize finalist; and was a finalist for the Indies Choice Award. He was selected as a Publishers Weekly Flying Start and an Indies Introduce pick. His books, which have received 21 starred reviews, have been translated into 15 languages and been featured on The Today Show, Good Morning America, and in Vanity Fair and People Magazine. Before becoming a writer, he was a musician who recorded with Iggy Pop, Nick Cave, and Debbie Harry. He lives in Nashville.

A Night at the Starglow: A Silent Film Experience Saturday, May 10, 2025 ~ 7:30 p.m. at The Alluvion

Put on your glad rags and travel back in time to the silent movie theatres of the early 1900s. The Alluvion's state-of-the-art performance space is reimagined as the Starglow Theatre, a vaudeville stage that has recently transitioned into a movie theatre. Interact with the theatre's staff—portrayed by Arts Academy theatre faculty—while pianist Steve Larson provides live accompaniment for classic films starring silver screen legends Charlie Chaplin and Buster Keaton.
